Construction of the store began last fall. The 14,620 square foot building occupies a 1.65 acre site and includes a 415 LF segmental wall, reaching a height of 25 feet, to create the parking area. The building has a brick veneer with EIFS accents, and all lighting, both interior and exterior, is LED.

The Jefferson City location is the tenth new ground-up retail store Coil has built for Goodwill, along with five other Goodwill retail stores it has renovated in Missouri and Illinois. "We are proud to continue our work with Goodwill," said David Coil, executive vice president of Coil Construction. "Coil Construction is dedicated to building a better community, and we are proud to work with clients like Goodwill to better serve the mid-Missouri area."

Goodwill uses revenue from its retail stores to fund employment and rehabilitation programs, which help people facing economic, physical and mental disadvantages find employment. Services in these programs include software training and job development and placement activities.
