## Coil Construction honored with two Hall of Fame awards

COLUMBIA, MO (April 28, 2020) – Coil Construction was recently honored with Hall of Fame awards from Varco Pruden Buildings for Best of Category in both office and warehouse construction.

Coil received the 2020 awards in the office category for the Cherry Hill Dental building on Nifong and the warehouse category for the Cartwright Business Technology Park. Both were entered in the Hall of Fame contest sponsored by Varco Pruden Buildings.

The Cherry Hill Dental building is a 19,899 square foot two-story building with a mezzanine and basement for medical office use. The building is a mix of precast concrete panels and fiber cement panels in a mosiac of colors, and the entire south side of the building is storefront windows.

The Cartwright Business Technology Park is a 55,000 square foot pre-engineered building with tilt-up concrete panel exterior walls. The building is part of a 500-acre development adjacent to the Columbia Regional Airport.
